1/4 MIDGETS -

All 1/4 Midgets must meet QMA Safety Rules per NJ State Rule Book.

Overall Treadwidth - Min 28", Max 36"

GO-KARTS -

All Karts must meet WKA motor and safety rules as per the NJ State Rulebook.

Age Limits For All Divisions Will Be 15 Years Old.

- **Stock Flathead 375**
- **Stock Animal Black Plate 375**
- **Sr. Champ Karts**
 - Animal Black Plate 425lbs / Flathead 410lbs
 - Seat must mounted in a manner so that it is not be within 6" of nerf bar at any point.
 - No lead on nerf bars. Lead cannot be mounted more than 3 1/2" from frame.
 - Lead cannot be stacked out to nerf bar. There must be a crush zone for safety.
 - Burris 33 or 55 Tire Rule. No softening at the event. Grinding in permitted area only.

Race Track - 1/10 Mile concrete oval treated with coke syrup for traction.

Pit Area - All Cars will be unloaded and pit in a designated area. Each car will be given a 4 ft by 6 ft area. All tools, spare parts, tires, etc must fit in this area. Please plan accordingly.

Pit Fee - No Age Limit In Pit Area. Anyone entering the pit area must pay \$20 insurance fee. Pit passes for children ages 14 and under that are not competing in event will be \$10.

Transponder Scoring - AMB Transponder scoring will be used for all timing and scoring. Transponder should be mounted on back of the roll cage or seat facing upwards as the scoring loop will be run over the track. Transponders will be available to rent for a fee if you do not own a transponder.

RACE PROCEDURES - Event will be run with a race director and corner workers. All rough riding calls will be made by race director.

All cars will get one round of 5 lap warm-ups, 10 minute time limits on qualifying races and 20 minute time limits for all feature events.

Heat race line-ups determined by pill draw. Amount of cars qualifying to feature event depended on car count. Consolation races will be run to give final opportunity to qualify.
